It also provides the platform for exhaustive competition where the strongest, fittest and most skilled will prevail.

Please be prepared for preliminary rounds of Kumite after the Kata Presentation on the Saturday.

The Gold Coast Budo Challenge promotes:

- ✓ inclusion for all ages and capabilities, from 4yrs to 104yrs; and
- ✓ excellent value for money with the 'double elimination' format in use across both Kata/forms and Kumite sections; and
- \checkmark safety, with varying degrees of protective padding used throughout the Kumite divisions.

Whilst every competitor competes in their own categories, they will also be competing against every other competitor on a unique points basis to determine the Kata Champion, Kumite Champion and Overall Champion Budoka of the Tournament. As you know by now, this is a true test of endurance.
